Saginaw County Department of Public Health Expands Groups to Receive H1N1 Vaccine at Second Public Clinic

Due to the availability of vaccine, the Saginaw County Department of Public Health will administer the H1N1 vaccine to the broader set of high risk groups identified by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) at the upcoming public H1N1 vaccine clinic scheduled for **Monday, November 2, 2009**, at the Dow Event Center. These groups include:

- pregnant women,
- persons who live with or provide care for infants aged <6 months (e.g., parents, siblings, and daycare providers),
- health-care and emergency medical services personnel,
- persons aged 6 months--**24 years**, and
- persons aged **25--64 years** who have medical conditions that put them at higher risk for influenza-related complications.

Individuals will be served on a first come, first serve basis from 2:00 pm to 6:00 pm.
