**Saginaw County Department of Public Health
Announces Second H1N1 Vaccine Clinic for
ALL MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC**

The Saginaw County Department of Public Health (SCDPH) announces that ALL MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC will again be able to receive the H1N1 vaccine at a clinic scheduled for Tuesday, December 15, 2009 from 2:00 pm to 5:00 pm at Jonesfield Township Hall, 217 N. Eddy St., in Merrill.

Due to availability of the vaccine, the Michigan Department of Community Health has expanded eligibility for the vaccine. SCDPH is pleased to now be able to administer the vaccine to any Saginaw County resident over the age of 6 months who wishes to receive it.

Any child who is 9 years old or younger, and received the first dose of the H1N1 flu vaccine on or before November 16, can obtain the second dose of the vaccine during this clinic. Parents/Guardians **MUST** bring their child's Influenza Vaccination Record in order to receive the second dose.

There is no charge to individuals for the vaccine. Persons wishing to get the vaccine for themselves or their children should bring proof of identification. Persons are also strongly encouraged to bring insurance cards with them to clinics, if available.

SCDPH continues to distribute H1N1 vaccine to enrolled area providers and pharmacies who will also administer doses.
